2024 VICTORIAN JUNIOR XC SKI CHAMPIONSHIPS


Fortunately enough snow arrived in time to run the Vic Junior Champs the weekend of 20-21 July. Saturday was the freestyle sprint races and Sunday the classic distance event BNSC members were well represented both days.

On a damp Saturday Harri Silvester won the sprint for under 20 men with Isaac Spring in 2nd place. Hannah Gray placed 2nd in the U20 women's sprint and Bethany Franzke placed third in the U16 sprint. New members Vasilisa Belova and Fedor Belov are the U12 sprint champs.

The weather greatly improved on Sunday and Vasilisa and Fedor again took out the honours in the U10 1km distance. Harri also took his same placing, 1st in the U20 7.5km distance with Isaac in 1st for U18. Bethany moved up to take 2nd in the U14 2.5km distance. Mitchell Hunt and Oliver Brewergray were 1st and 2nd respectively in the U12 1.5km distance.

WAXING CLINIC

On the 25th July more than 20 people attended a XC waxing clinic with Jacob Huseby presented by BNSC and Snow Australia. Jacob, a US ski coach who is currently the Falls Creek National Training Centre Coach, has a wealth of experience having waxed for the Estonian World Cup Team and worked with the Start Wax team at world cups in Finland.

Jacob provided an educational evening for those interested in ski selection, base preparation including hand structuring glide waxing in the new non fluor era, and of course the intricacies of kick waxing. Some key take-aways from the session:

- Clean your skis, dirt is not your friend.
- When putting structure on your bases, think in regards

to creating moisture when snow conditions are dry, or expelling moisture when snow conditions are wet.

Wax colder than you think.


2024 AUSTRALIAN XC SKI CHAMPIONSHIPS

Another successful AUS XC Ski Champs were run by BNSC the weekend of 27-28 July. Saturday was the classic sprint races and Sunday the freestyle distance event. A timely snowfall just prior to the weekend allowed for some interesting courses to be set, which were well received by competitors.

The snowfalls eased for BNSC members Jayden Spring and Phil Bellingham to battle it out in the men's sprint final with Jayden taking the win 3 seconds ahead of Phil. Club member Hannah Price made it into the sprint final, but just missed out on a place.
